To Our Patients:

We would like to familiarize you with the unique nature of our surgical practice for the management of vascular disease. Our doctors do not have their own individual patients. Rather; you may be seen by any one of our professionals on the initial visit or on subsequent follow-up appointments.

The doctors and physicians assistants/nurse practitioners (mid-levels) work very closely with one another, discuss individual cases amongst themselves, and operate as a team if surgery is necessary for your problem. Most vascular surgery procedures require two trained professionals and this team approach will benefit you should an operation be required.

This type of practice arrangement enables the doctors and our mid-levels to be very familiar with all of the individual patient's problems. Thus, in the event of a particular doctor's unavailability on a given day, another doctor or extender in the practice will respond to your questions or needs. Likewise, you will benefit from the vascular surgeons consulting each other on diagnostic and therapeutic problems.

We strongly believe that you will find that our coordinated team approach to patient management enhances the quality and timeliness of the care that you will receive. Please feel free to discuss this with the doctors, mid-levels or with our office staff if you have any concerns or questions.

Please bring the following information with you on the day of your appointment:

- All insurance cards
- Photo ID (i.e. driver's license)
- Co-pays (for provider appointment and for testing)
- If you have no supplemental insurance to your Medicare, the copay is collected at the time of your visit
- Referral(s) if needed (referrals are the responsibility of the patient to secure and take to your visit)
- Any medical records that pertain to your visit (i.e. Ultrasounds, CT scans, MRI, etc.)
